I write as ex-president of Claremorris Chamber of Commerce and member of Mayo Chambers.

This submission refers to the draft RSES Report.

I strongly welcome and support Objectives 115 (a) and 115 (b) of the draft RSES Report which refer specifically to the re-opening of the Western Rail Corridor from Claremorris to Athenry and northwards from Claremorris to Sligo. I believe the redevelopment of this infrastructure to be vital for the future of our region both from an economic and environmental perspective.

Rail infrastructure has very important role to play in the development of a spine of infrastructure along the western seaboard allowing our people and goods to move in environmentally and efficient manner and encouraging balanced regional economic development. In particular this section of rail line connects Mayo/Galway to the south of Ireland opening up the southern ports to goods leaving the western region.

The rail line has the potential to take thousands of daily car commuters off the road currently travelling from North Galway & Mayo into Galway city. Indeed the success of the reopening of the line from Limerick to Galway for daily commuters provides clear evidence to justify reopening the line north of Athenry.
